SEMINAR OVERVIEW:

The field of dental implants has undergone a profound paradigm shift in both the science and techniques. Dental implants smile aesthetics in 2020 should be predictable. Further, cutting edge surgical techniques can often to salvage previous aesthetic misadventures. Dr. Novack will be presenting the most current literature based guidance on how to achieve predictable aesthetic success.

Patients present at our offices in search of not merely a profound enhancement in their current facial aesthetics, but for a lasting facial and smile improvement. Prior to embarking on complex orthodontic, periodontal, grafting and implant procedures followed by prosthetic rehabilitation, it is essential to also consider the effects of aging. The most current data on facial changes throughout life will be presented. Guidance will be provided on the effects of aging along with gender specificity. Such insight then can direct implant placement by considering vectors of continued skeletal growth. Treatment sequencing, number of implants, hard and soft tissue grafting, site optimization along with provisional and definitive restorative design will be discussed. Our beautifully crafted smile must radiate long into the future.

- Present a decision matrix that provides guidance when deciding between a conventional fixed prosthesis versus dental implant treatment.
Predict potential aesthetic implant failures prior to starting a case.
Assess the potential for hard and soft tissue improvements to ameliorate aesthetically compromised dental implants.
Managing aesthetic dental implant failures; Etiologic treatment solutions.
Strategies to mitigate the risks of implant malposition.
Discuss the benefits of inter-disciplinary collaboration (perio-ortho-prosth) prior, intra treatment, provisionalization and crown customization to optimize peri-implant tissue aesthetics.
Analysis of the continuing impact of aging on the pre maxilla. Both intra and extra oral skeletal changes.
MIT- Minimally invasive treatment should be our guide.
